Presentation Guidelines.

Your presentation should last between **and minutes.**

If you need more time, please ask me first !

Everyone in your group must have a speaking part in the presentation.

Use your voice ! Speak Loudly and Clearly. Try not to speak too fast as people will not be able to understand you.

DO NOT read too much ! You can use cue cards and other aids to help give a good presentation, but **do not just read from a script !**

Look at the people in the audience - **EYE CONTACT** is important !

You must use some props (pictures, maps, music, etc.) as they make your presentation more interesting and easier to understand.

No Props = - 3 points

Be careful with using too many difficult or unusual words. If people cannot understand you - they will not enjoy your presentation ! You should **do your best to help the audience understand any special vocabulary** that you use in your presentation.
